Important Dates

- **Registration Opens:** September 15, 2025
- **Registration Deadline:** Friday, October 17, 2025
- **Art Drop-off:** October 22 & 23, 2025 | 11:00 AM–4:00 PM
- **Reception:** Thursday, November 6, 2025 | 6:00–8:00 PM
- **Art Pick-up:** November 12 & 13, 2025 | 11:00 AM–4:00 PM

Late submissions will not be accepted. Works left more than 30 days after the pick-up date become the property of Arts Davidson County.

Eligibility

Students must be enrolled in grades 6–12 and meet one of the following:

- Currently enrolled in Davidson County Schools, Lexington City Schools, or Thomasville City Schools
- Currently enrolled in a private/independent school within Davidson County
- Currently enrolled in a registered homeschool within Davidson County

Limit: 2 pieces per student. There is no limit per teacher, class, or school. Teachers are encouraged to submit the strongest and most original work to ensure a high-quality, diverse exhibit.

Accepted Artwork

2-D Art: Watercolor, Acrylic, Oil, Pen & Ink, Photography, Printmaking, Mixed Media, Digital, Other (maximum size: 18" x 24")

3-D Art: Ceramics, Glass, Mosaic, Fiber, Wood, Paper Mâché, Metal, Other

Not Accepted:

- Modeling clay artwork
- Lego or kit-based creations
- Works considered too fragile for transport/installation
- Collaborative/group projects
- Glass frames

Artwork Preparation

- All 2-D works must be mounted or matted (no larger than 18" x 24").
- Labels (provided) must be attached to the front of artwork.
- Adhesive will be added to the back for installation.
- Teachers/parents are responsible for ensuring submissions are original works.
- Any piece not properly prepared for display may be withdrawn from the exhibit.

Arts Davidson County reserves the right to refuse any work that does not meet guidelines.

Awards

- Every student receives a **Certificate of Excellence**.
- Top entries in each grade range and medium are recognized with **Excellence in Art Awards** thoughtfully selected art supplies and creative resources to inspire continued artistic growth.
- **To enhance the experience for our students and recognize their achievements, a teacher or administrative staff member from each participating school or group is required to attend the reception.** Students are excited to share their work and see

familiar faces supporting them — it is always disappointing for them when no one from their school is present. Your attendance ensures that these young artists feel celebrated and supported.
